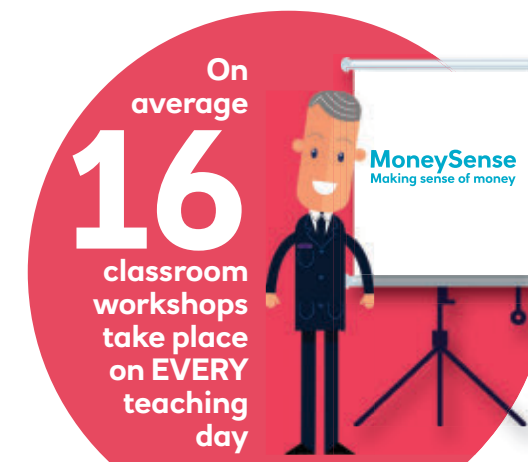

**97%** of teachers think the involvement of business can improve their delivery of financial education

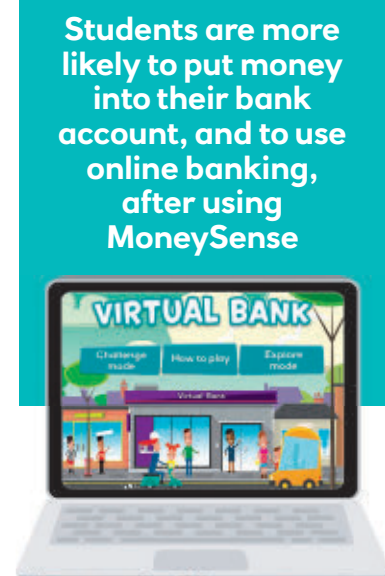
